

History of the Goltz Family¹

Yekutiel

The story of the Goltz family begins in Jalowka, Poland² with Yekutiel Shalom(b.c.1826)³ who married Shaska Gutman(b.c.1826) around 1844.⁴ They had at least four children: Fanny(Feiga)(c.1856-1931)⁵, Cherna(d.>1935)⁶, Louis(Aryeh Laib)(1860-1935)⁷, and Eliyahu(1863-1938).⁸

Cherna married ? Goldstein.⁹

Feiga married Benjamin (Berel) Frumkes (1850>1930)¹⁰ in 1872.¹¹ Their first child was born shortly thereafter: Joseph (Yossel)(1873-1945).¹² By 1876 they were living in Białystok (today, in Poland)¹³ and had other children¹⁴: Clara(1876-1959)¹⁵, Frieda(Faigel), Hishl/Hishke (Chaya)(b.1886)¹⁶, Ida(b.1891)¹⁷, and Rose(b.1894).¹⁸

Joseph came to the US in 1900 and settled in Manhattan, NY.¹⁹ Hishke came in 1904.²⁰ Ida came to the US in 1905²¹, followed by Ben in 1906, and then Fanny and Rose in 1907.²²

They settled in New York, where Ben worked selling cigars and also worked as a rabbi.²³ Clara came to the US in 1912.²⁴ Frieda also settled in the U.S.²⁵

Ida Rose Clara Hishke Joseph

Ida married Max Landman(b.1896)²⁶ from New York in 1919.²⁷ They lived in the Bronx and had two children: Bella(1920-1932?)²⁸, and Carl(1921-1987).²⁹

Rose married Charles(Clarence) C Hirsch(b.1893)³⁰ from New York in 1924.³¹ They had two daughters: Diana(1924-2003)³², and Elaine(b.1930).³³

Clara married Wolf Liatsky(1875-1932)³⁴ around 1896. They settled in Aradok (Horodok) near Bialystok. There, they had several children: Rose(b.1897)³⁵, Mollie(1900-1964)³⁶, Harry(1901-1977)³⁷, Lillian(1903-1977)³⁸, and Sol(1904-1991).³⁹ Wolf immigrated to America in 1909 and took the last name of Light.⁴⁰ In 1912, Clara and the children followed him to the US.⁴¹ The family settled in Brooklyn, NY⁴² where their sixth child, Alexander(1914-1977)⁴³ was born.

Hishke, also known as Hishl, married ? and lived in Chicago.⁴⁴

Joseph was married to Sofie(Sara) Soloveichek(1877-1936)⁴⁵ in 1898.⁴⁶ They lived in Bialystok and had one daughter, Rosalie(b.1899).⁴⁷ They immigrated to the US in 1900 and lived in Pennsylvania, where their son, Harry(b.1902)⁴⁸ was born. They then lived in Mahattan by 1904, where Joseph owned a dry goods store⁴⁹ and, there, had two other sons: Otto(Aron)(1904-2004)⁵⁰, and Saul(b.1905).⁵¹ By 1915 they were living ninety miles north of Manhattan in Fallsburgh NY, then in Brooklyn by 1930. Following Sofie's death, Joseph moved to Los Angeles, CA, where his son, Saul, was living. There, he married Fannie Siegel(Lustig)(1884-1955)⁵² from Russia in 1941.⁵³

Eliyahu Cherna

Eli married Fannie Raffel(1866-1951).⁵⁴ They lived in Zabłudow⁵⁵, near Bialystok, and had three children: Hyman(1889-1980), Joseph(1891-1975), and Sophie(1899-1979). They immigrated to the US in 1905 and lived in Chicago.⁵⁶

Aryeh Laib married Anna(Chana Baile) Sheinberg(1862-1943) from Jalowka, in 1887.⁵⁷ They lived in Jalowka, and there had two children: Sophie(b.1888-1956)⁵⁸, and Benjamin (1889-1970).⁵⁹ Louis immigrated to the US in 1889.⁶⁰ He was followed by Anna and the children between 1890 and 1895.⁶¹ They lived in Chicago and had several other children:?(c.1894-c.1894)⁶², Sam(1895-1899)⁶³, Joseph Yale(George)(1896-1984)⁶⁴, and David(1897-1907).⁶⁵

Nettie

There is another member of the Goltz family, connected to Yekutiel but whose relationship is not yet determined. This was Nettie Goltz(c.1845-<1935).⁶⁶ She may have been Yekutiel's sister, his niece (the daughter of Yekutiel's brother), or another child of Yekutiel.⁶⁷

Nettie was married to Tuvyah Aryeh Goldman.⁶⁸ They lived in Krinki, Poland⁶⁹, and had at least one child, Samuel(c.1865-1943).⁷⁰

Nettie Samuel

Samuel was married to Mary S(1868-1920)⁷¹ around 1890.⁷² Either Sam immigrated in 1885 and they were married in the US, or they were married in Poland and immigrated together to the US in 1890.⁷³ They settled in Chicago, and, there, had twelve children: Louis(1891-1963)⁷⁴, Nicholas(1892-1961)⁷⁵, George(1893-1954)⁷⁶, Charles(Carl K)(b.1895)⁷⁷, Harry(1896-1979)⁷⁸, William(1898-1972)⁷⁹, Bessie(1899-1989)⁸⁰, Benjamin(1901-1965)⁸¹, Nathaniel(1903-1961)⁸², Daniel(1904-1985)⁸³, Emma(1906-<1989)⁸⁴, and David(1907-1969)⁸⁵. Following Mary's death, Samuel married Esther (b.1883) from Romania in 1927.⁸⁶

“Jałówka is situated in a densely forested area on an old trade route from Minsk to Warsaw, through which flows the Jałówka River. The town was founded at the beginning of the 16th century by Queen Bona, wife of King Zygmunt I, and in 1548 was granted its city charter by King Zygmunt August. In 1795, it was annexed to Prussia and in 1807 was incorporated into the Russian Empire. Jałówka was not connected to the railway network, and its economy remained characteristically rural: its residents earned their livelihoods from agriculture, light commerce and from workmanship.

The first Jews settled in Jałówka at the end of the 18th century. In 1870, the community consisted of 400 people. Their sources of livelihood were light commerce, and various skills—principally carpentry and tailoring—yet there were among them also bakers, butchers, coopers (barrel makers) and many wagoners (Jałówka's form of transportation and hauling from which wagons were harnessed to horses). The Jews lived in the area of the market and maintained stores and stands there. Aside from their homes, they kept small animal pens and vegetable patches for their own use; sometimes a cow, goat, or a horse. At the end of the 19th century, the number of Jews approached its peak—approximately 750 people (56.7% of the general population)—but from then on the number decreased as a result of emigration and departure for the large cities. In the first years, there was no independent Jewish community in Jałówka, and the Jews belonged to the community of Svisloch (6 miles east, now in Belarus). In the first half of the 19th century, with the growth of their number, they established a *kehillah* (Jewish community); sanctified a cemetery outside of town; and built a wooden synagogue, with a *Talmud Torah* (religious study for children) class and *beit midrash* (religious study for adults). In the synagogue the well-to-do prayed, and the *beit midrash* even served the craftsmen and simple folks. Aside from a *hevra kaddisha* (burial society), charity and assistance groups, such as *Hachnasat Orchim* (Welcoming Strangers), *Hachnasat Kala* (Welcoming the Bride) and others were also active in Jałówka.”

There were two cemeteries in Jałówka. The first was in the center of the village, north of the market square. It was established in the 1800s with the last burial in 1800s. It no longer exists. The second is located in a rural area on a hillside at a fork in the roads that lead to Kondratki and Gonczary. It was established in the 1800s with the last burial in 1941. Most of the cemetery is gone due to devastation during WWII and post-war agricultural use. Only a handful of gravestones remained as of 2004. In 2007 nothing remained. (“Jalowka,” Kehillah Links, JewishGen.com).
